From either northbound or southbound I-5, take I-205 exit toward Vancouver, WA. Use Hwy. 500 East (Exit 30-Orchards Exit). Go east on Hwy. 500 to Fourth Plain (1st light) and turn right continuing on Hwy. 500 East (Camas). Go 6.3 miles, then turn left on 53rd St. Go 3.2 miles, and turn left on Ireland Rd. Go 0.3 miles and turn left on Lessard Rd. Continue on Lessard Road (turns into Boulder Rd.) for 4 miles. Veer left at the fork, and proceed toward the parking lot/staging area.
